- ★ Membership in the American Junior Southdown Association
- ★ Must own at least one Southdown
- ★ Age 16-21 as of January 1, 2017
- ★ Must have an active email and be able to participate in AJSA Ambassador conference calls

Ambassador Responsibilities

- ★ Required to participate in a leadership role in at least one National Southdown Event. May attend any one or more of the following:
 - National Southdown Sale in Richmond, IN April 29th
 - All American Junior Show at Madison, WI June 30th – July 2nd
 - North American International Livestock Exposition in Louisville, KY November 10th – 12th
- ★ Promote the AJSA through written articles, blogs, exhibits, and photographs using email, Facebook, Twitter, and other online media
- ★ Attend sheep events within their state or region and promote the Southdown breed
- ★ Communicate and assist in planning junior activities and events with fellow AJSA Ambassadors
- ★ Serve as a member of the AJSA Ambassador team for two years
